Attendance and Punctuality

Research suggests that 17 missed school days a year (92% attendance) = 1 GCSE grade dropped.

If they have had 9 days or more off school in a year their attendance is below 95%!

Bringing their equipment: Knowledge Books, pens, calculators.

Well-being

Getting enough sleep is sleep.

Eating well.

Encourage your child to take breaks from revision - they shouldn't be revising for longer than an hour without a short break.

Use regular praise and encouragement to help them start on revision tasks.

Help them enjoy the moment; spend time together not thinking about school.

Limit their access to social media.

Let them know that what they are feeling is totally normal.
