The next big milestone is GCSE results day, on **Thursday 22<sup>th</sup> August**.

**Please read this letter carefully as it contains lots of key information.**

**The day:**

You can come into school **from 9am** on Thursday 22<sup>th</sup> August.

You will be directed to the RLT, where envelopes will be arranged in alphabetical order. by your legal surname.

The envelope will contain a 'statement of results', plus information on the various Post Results Services including reviews of marking and the costs involved – you must fill these in **before** you leave.

Results collection will **end at 11am**. If you have not collected your results, they will be posted out to your home address the following day.

Once you have your results, you can walk to Savannah to sign up for your A Level courses if you are staying with us.

**What if I am away and can't collect my results?**

You have two options if you are unable to collect your GCSE results in person.

1. If you would like to receive your results in an email on results day or sent 1<sup>st</sup> class post on results day, please let Mrs Wilson know at [gwilson@ben.srscmat.co.uk](mailto:gwilson@ben.srscmat.co.uk) by **August 12<sup>th</sup> August**. You must use your school email to access your results.
2. If you would like someone else to collect your results on your behalf, email Mrs Wilson **from your school email address** by **August 19<sup>th</sup>** with their name and their connection to yourself. The nominated person will need to **bring photo ID** with them on the day or we will not be able to give them your results.

**A call or message on results day is not acceptable.**
