This can either be handed in to Reception (marked Exams Post Results Services) or can be scanned and emailed to gwilson@ben.srscmat.co.uk. Please note that a signature from the student is required.

Please also take note of the deadlines for the services as well as the costs. Any review of marking is costed per paper, not per subject and will only be actioned when payment is received. Payment should be made via cheque payable to: Saint Benedict CVA or Cash (exact money only).
