Help them to find success in the classroom and beyond. Give them the courage and strength to overcome any of the challenges that they may face.


Grant us the patience, wisdom and courage to challenge them, guide them, and love them in every moment.

## Attendance and Punctuality

Research suggests that 17 missed school days a year (92% attendance) = 1 GCSE grade dropped.

If they have had 9 days or more off school in a year their attendance is below 95%!


## **Being Prepared**



#### Literature:

2 papers

Paper 1 is 1 hour and 45 minutes each – covering 'Romeo and Juliet' and 'A Christmas Carol'

Paper 2 is 2 hours and 15 mins and covers 'Animal Farm' the 'Power and Conflict' Poetry Anthology and Unseen poetry.









**Homework:** We have created videos that guide pupils through how we answer questions






**Learning the information:** Making your own flashcards, using mini whiteboards to learn information, chanting the information.


